OPENING TIPS

- The win over Tennessee marks back-to-back season-opening wins on the road against SEC competition. Topped Georgia 92-90 in overtime, to start 2015-16.

- Received five votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

- Ranked No. 9 in the preseason CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25. ETSU is No. 21 while fellow SoCon member Mercer is receiving votes (36th).

- 70-31 (.693) over last four seasons. That ranks No. 1 in the state of Tennessee ahead of Belmont (68-33), Middle Tennessee (69-36), Memphis (61-39), ETSU (60-42), Vanderbilt (55-45) and Tennessee (55-49). Among SoCon teams overall, the Mocs lead ahead of Wofford (63-37, .630) and Mercer (66-40, .623).

- 0-4 all-time vs. North Carolina with the last meeting coming in the 1977-78 season. Series notes on page 4.

- 12-40 all-time against ACC schools: Clemson 2-0, Florida State 0-2, Georgia Tech 2-15, Louisville 6-5, North Carolina 0-4, N.C. State 1-0, Notre Dame 0-1, Virginia Tech 1-1 and Wake Forest 0-2. Last win against the league? March 15, 1985 in the first round of the NIT in Chattanooga, a 67-65 OT win over a Horace Grant-led Clemson Tiger squad.

- Coach **Matt McCall** is the fastest Mocs coach to 30 wins (36 games). **Ron Shumate** (1972-79) opened his career 30-11. Former Tar Heel **Jeff Lebo** (2002-04) and **Mack McCarthy** (1985-97) did it 44.

- Three graduate seniors - **Casey Jones, Tre' McLean & Justin Tuoyo** - chose to stay with program rather than depart for another school after May 2016 ceremony.

- Nice blend of experience and youth with basically five starters back including the return of Jones after medical redshirt. Played first eight games before an ankle injury in practice before the win at Dayton ended his season. Active roster features six seniors, one junior, four sophomores and three freshmen.

- Last year's squad was 10-6 when trailing at some point in the second half, 29-1 when leading at some point. "Mocs Record When..." is on page eight.

- The Mocs play six of its first seven contests, seven of 11, away from the friendly confines of McKenzie Arena.

HEAD COACH MATT MCCALL

- **Matt McCall** (Florida '04) is 30-6 entering his second year as a collegiate head coach.

- 13-1 at home, 12-4 away & 5-1 on a neutral floor.

- 0-0 against the ACC.

- 29 wins led the nation for first-year head coaches in 2015-16. Tied for seventh-most (Stan Heath-Kent State) since 1963.

- 2016 Southern Conference Coach of the Year.

Named in both the coaches and media votes.

Seventh UTC SoCon Coach of the Year joining *Murray Arnold* (1982, 1983), *Mack McCarthy* (1986, 1992, 1993) and *Will Wade* (2014).

- Joined *Mack McCarthy* (1985-86) as the only Mocs head coaches to win SoCon Regular Season title in first year. Matches *John Shulman* (2004-05) in winning SoCon Tourney in first effort for school.

- McCall is a 2004 graduate of Florida. He spent 10 seasons with Billy Donovan working as a student manager (2003-06), director of basketball ops (2006-08) and assistant coach (2011-15). He spent three seasons as an assistant to *Mike Jarvis* at Florida Atlantic (2008-11) culminating with a school-best 21-11 mark in 2010-11.

FOR STARTERS

- School-record 29 wins a season ago. Most by SoCon program since Davidson in 2007-08 (29-7).

Record for overall wins? 30. **North Carolina** (30-5, 1945-46) and N.C. State (30-7, 1950-51).

- 29 victories tied for seventh-most in the country.

- Finished with an NCAA RPI of 56.

- 19th 20-win season and first back-to-back 20-win campaigns since 1993 (26-7) and 1994 (23-7).

- 51 wins over the previous two campaigns was most since 53 in 1981-82 (27) and 1982-83 (26).

- Won 30 SoCon titles in 39 years. That's accounted by 11 regular season, 11 tournament and eight division crowns. More history on page five.

- Went 23-4 after season-ending injury to SoCon Preseason Player of the Year **Casey Jones** prior to the win at Dayton.

- Returning production: 66.8 percent of scoring, 61.7 percent of rebounding, 74.4% of assists, 71.0% of steals and 78.8% of blocks.

STUDENT-ATHLETE INTERVIEWS

Coach McCall and student-athletes are available every practice day 30 minutes prior to the session's start. Please make specific requests at least 24 hours in advance to ensure student-athlete availability.

COVERING PRACTICE

UTC basketball practices are closed to the media. There are select practice during the season that are open and the media is advised well in advance of those occurrences.

GAMEDAY PROCEDURES

No UTC coach or player is available to the media prior to gametime.

POSTGAME PROCEDURES - HOME

The UTC locker room is closed. Following a "10-minute cooling off" period, McCall comes to the media room first followed by visiting team coach (if requested). Selected Mocs follow the visiting coach. Visiting player availability and locker room accessibility depends on that team's procedures.

POSTGAME PROCEDURES - ROAD

The UTC locker room is closed. Following a "10-minute cooling off" period, McCall and selected student-athletes report to the Mocs Sports Network radio location for the post-game show unless the home team requires media room presence.

SOCON TELECONFERENCE

The Southern Conference hosts a weekly teleconference for its men's basketball coaches during the spring semester. A complete schedule will be emailed upon release.

SOCON WEEKLY AWARDS

Every Tuesday during the regular season, the Southern Conference announces its Player of the Week. There is also a monthly award that will be announced early in the month following the previous one's competition.

IN THE PAINT

- Senior **Justin Tuoyo** anchors the post. He's a 2-time Southern Conference Defensive Player of the Year ('15 & '16).
- **Tuoyo** posted a career-best 22 points while collecting 11 boards in Friday's win at Tennessee.
- **Tuoyo** holds the UTC record for career blocks (183).
- Senior **Casey Jones** is at his familiar spot at the 4 after a season-ending ankle injury last year led to a fifth-year for the New Orleans native.
- **Jones** was originally ticketed to play the 3 before **Chuck Ester's** knee injury in the preseason put him on the shelf indefinitely.
- **Jones** was one of a handful players around the nation leading his team in points, rebound and assists when injury struck a year ago.
- Sophomore **Makinde London** is the primary backup to **Tuoyo** at the 5, but he's also a natural 4. He was cleared by the NCAA prior to the Tennessee game after transferring from Xavier during the summer.
- **London** had two points, four rebounds and one assist in 16 minutes Friday night.
- Junior college transfers **Nat Dixon** (soph.) and **Trayvond Massenburg** (jr.) provide depth at the 4 and 5 with **Dixon** also capable of sliding over to the 3.
- Senior **Tre' McLean** can also play the 4.

ON THE PERIMETER

- **McLean** opens at the 3. He's seen time at the 1-4 over the last two seasons, but primarily on the wing.
- **McLean** scored 21 points with 10 rebounds while

tying his career high with four steals on Friday night.

- **Greg Pryor** is in his fourth year starting at the 1.
- **Pryor** has 880 points, 268 assists and 125 steals over his 99 contests.
- **Johnathan Burroughs-Cook** overcame early foul trouble Friday to tally 11 points, all in the second half. He played 22 minutes, but just four in the opening frame.
- **Rodney Chatman** is the backup point guard. He acquitted himself well in his collegiate debut with two points, one rebounds, two assists and two steals in 14 minutes.

HIGH MAJOR PROGRESS

Prior to the start of the 2015-16 season, the Mocs had gone 10 seasons without a win over a high major team: 0-26.
