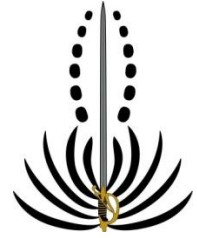

Series History: North Carolina leads 2-0

Sword Points:

- This is the third meeting between the Silverswords and Tar Heels, all at the Maui Jim Maui Invitational. The last meeting was on Nov. 21, 2012 in the third-place game, a 112-70 UNC win. The only other meeting was on Nov. 24, 2008 where the Tar Heels won 115-70 in the first round.
- This is Chaminade's 33rd consecutive year in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, having served as the host institution since the tournament's creation. The Silverswords are 7-87 lifetime on Maui while North Carolina is making its seventh appearance on the Valley Island. UNC is 16-3 lifetime in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, tied for the most wins with Duke in the history of the tournament.
- Chaminade's last win on Maui was on Nov. 19, 2012 when it defeated Texas, 86-73. The Silverswords' highest finish in the Invitational is second in the tournament's inaugural year in 1984 when it was a four-team field. Since the tournament expanded to an eight-team format in 1986, their highest finish is fourth which they have accomplished four times, most recently in 2012 when the 'Swords lost to UNC in the third place game.

Sixth-year head coach Eric Bovaird is continuing the winning tradition of men's basketball at Chaminade University of Honolulu.

In 2014, he guided the Silverswords to the Pacific West Conference Tournament championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Division II West Regional. It was the first time in school history the 'Swords earned back-to-back trips to the regional, having captured an at-large berth in 2013. He also guided CUH to the championship game of the PacWest Conference Tournament, that same year in Azusa, Calif.

Entering the 2016-17 season, Bovaird is 71-65 at Chaminade, the third-winningest coach in program history, while his winning percentage (.522) is fourth-best. His first-ever recruit, Lee Bailey, was a three-time member of the All-PacWest Team, a four-time Academic All-PacWest selection while earning Daktronics All-West Region honors in 2014, finishing his career sixth in the all-time school's scoring list with 1,426 points. Bovaird also helped De'Andre Haskins earn PacWest Player of the Year honors in 2013.

Having perhaps the toughest schedule in NCAA Division II annually certainly prepares the Swords for the postseason, none more than playing in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational, which features some of the best Division I college programs from around the nation and televised across the nation on the ESPN family of networks. The buzz of the 2012 version was the 'Swords' first round upset of Texas, considered to be one of the greatest wins since the historic 1982 victory over No. 1 Virginia. The win over the Longhorns sent the social media world a blaze even being one of the trending topics on Twitter.

In addition to playing three Division I heavyweights on Maui, Bovaird, along with CUH Athletics Director, Bill Villa, added a fourth Division I foe. This time with the neighboring University of Hawai'i, the state's only Division I school which is less than a mile away from the Chaminade campus.

The December 2012 game between the Swords and Rainbow Warriors was played in a unique setting, the island of Moloka'i, the first-ever basketball game involving a Division I team on the Friendly Isle. In 2013, the game was played in Lihue, Kaua'i.

Bovaird has also been able to place several former Swords into the professional hoops ranks, including Haskins (Luxembourg) and Dominique Cooks and Bennie Murray (Australia).

Bovaird was a long-time first assistant at fellow NCAA Division II member, West Liberty University, in Wheeling, W.Va. In his seven years at West Liberty, the Hilltoppers had the highest winning percentage in all of NCAA Division II men's basketball. Over that seven-year stretch, WLU led the nation in scoring five times. In his final season at West Liberty in 2010-11, the Hilltoppers finished 33-1 and averaged 111 points per game.

Bovaird has been very instrumental in developing the most exciting, winning style of basketball in the country. West Liberty has garnished national attention with its ferocious full court pressure defense and instant offense, which Bovaird has implemented.

Not only has Bovaird had a storied coaching career, but he also was a two time All-American while playing at West Liberty from 1992-95. After a career in which he broke most of the Hilltoppers' scoring records, he accepted offers to play professionally in both Europe and Australia from 1996-98.

Bovaird is married to Dr. Leigh Bovaird, and they have three children; Jane, Brooks and Blaine. They currently reside in Honolulu.

A Look at the Tar Heels:

North Carolina started the year 3-0 with wins over Tulane, Chattanooga and Long Beach State. Preseason All-ACC First Team selection Joel Berry II is averaging 21.3 points per game followed by Justin Jackson at 17.0 ppg. Kennedy Meeks is the Tar Heels' top rebounder at 11.3 rpg along with three blocks. UNC is shooting 50.3 percent from the floor and is out-rebounding opponents, 49-39.

Chaminade vs. North Carolina, last meeting:

The Tar Heels downed the Silverswords, 112-70, in the third-place game of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational on Nov. 12, 2012. 'Swords guard De'Andre Haskins solidified his place on the all-tournament team by hitting 9-of-15 shots including 4-for-6 from 3-point range for a team-high 22 points along with six rebounds and four assists. Haskins averaged 24 points and six boards per game in the tournament. Bennie Murray added 15 points for CUH. Five Tar Heels scored in double-digits, led by James McAdoo's 18 points and 10 rebounds.

Maui Magic:

The Silverswords have their share of success in the Maui Jim Maui Invitational over the years. The following are the all-time wins for the 'Swords on the Valley Isle:

Recapping the PacWest/GNAC Challenge:

The Silverswords are off to a 2-0 start for the sixth time in the past seven seasons. Chaminade downed No. 12 Alaska Anchorage, 92-81, in the Challenge opener on Nov. 11, getting career-highs from Rohndell Goodwin (29 points) and Dantley Walker (19 points). Kiran Shastri also had 19 points in the win. The 'Swords then defeated Alaska the following night, 80-66, behind Shastri's 22 points while Goodwin added 19 points, nine rebounds and five assists. Shastri and Goodwin were both named to the Challenge All-Tournament team.

Up Next for Chaminade:

The Silverswords will face either Oklahoma State or Connecticut on Tuesday. Chaminade is 0-1 lifetime against the UConn, losing in a consolation game in the 2000 Maui Jim Maui Invitational, 77-61. The Silverswords have never faced Oklahoma State.

Running Men:

Chaminade has 41 games of 90 or more points during the Eric Bovaird Era (142 games). In the four years prior to his arrival, the 'Swords had 11 90-point games, requiring 109 games to accomplish the feat during that span (2007-11). They also have 15 games of 100 or more points, eight of those coming last season which tied the school record set in 1991-92.

Three-Point Mania:

Since Eric Bovaird became head coach in 2011, the Silverswords have been among the top 3-point shooting teams in the nation. West Liberty, where Bovaird was an assistant and which is also his alma mater, annually finishes near the top nationally in Division II in 3-pointers made. Last year, the 'Swords were 17th in the nation in 3-pointers made per game (10.4). Through two games this season, Chaminade has made 24 triples, hitting them at a 45.3 percent clip (24-of-53).

Three for Shastri:

Kiran Shastri broke the school's career 3-point record early last year and continues to add on to his career total. Through his first 84 career games, the senior has drilled 244 triples. As a freshman in 2013-14, the Orinda, Calif., native set the school single-season record with 93 made 3-pointers, hitting them at a 43.7 percent clip, which not only led the conference, but was good for 18th nationally. He has also made at least one triple in 81 of 84 career games and began his career with a made 3-pointer in his first 42 career contests. Shastri was also named to the PacWest/GNAC Challenge All-Tournament Team last week after averaging 20.5 points and four 3-pointers per game.

Kuany Kuany; Double Trouble:

Kuany Kuany is a double-double machine for the Silverswords. The junior guard has 23 career double-doubles, 11 coming last season when he was named to the All-PacWest Second Team. The Melbourne, Australia native also gets the job done in the classroom, having earned Academic All-PacWest honors in each of his first three seasons. Kuany is also making the ascension towards the higher echelons of the career scoring and rebounding lists with 1,299 career points (9th) and 710 career boards (5th).

Happy To Be Home:

The Silverswords have enjoyed the comforts of McCabe Gym over the years. Since 2006, the 'Swords are 86-39 (.688) overall at home and 57-30 (.655) in the PacWest. Under Eric Bovaird, Chaminade is 39-22 (.639) overall and 31-17 (.646) in the conference. Since the start of the 2012-13 season, CUH owns a 35-15 (.700) mark overall at home with two of the losses coming to a pair of 2012 national champions: Western Washington, the NCAA Division II champs; and Cedarville, which captured the National Christian College Athletic Association national title, both games coming in the fall of 2013. The 'Swords are also 27-12 (.692) in PacWest home games during the same stretch.

Great Starts:
