♦ Atlantic Coast Conference champion North Carolina (17-2), the defending NCAA champion, will play for its seventh NCAA final four berth in the last nine years when it hosts unseeded Navy (17-4) at 1 p.m. on Saturday at Fetzer Field in the NCAA Tournament quarterfinals.

♦ The game will be streamed live by ESPN3.

♦ A win against Navy would send the Tar Heels to the NCAA semifinals for the seventh time in the last nine years and its 10th overall.

♦ The winner of Saturday's game will advance to an NCAA semifinal next Friday against the winner of the quarterfinal game between Boston College and Southern California. The NCAA semifinals and final will be played on May 26 and 28 at Gillette Stadium in Foxboro, Mass., home of the NFL's New England Patriots.

♦ Carolina is the two-time defending Atlantic Coast Conference champion and has won three consecutive ACC regular season titles.

♦ Carolina is ranked No. 3 in the nation in the IWLCA coaches poll and No. 2 in the Cascade media poll this week. Navy is unranked but received votes in the media poll.

♦ Carolina has won 34 of its last 36 games.

### FETZER FINALE BEFORE RENOVATION

♦ Saturday will mark the final event in Fetzer Field, the longtime home of the Tar Heel lacrosse and soccer programs, before renovations begin at

the venue on Monday May 21.

♦ Fetzer was built in 1935, and the Carolina women's lacrosse team has played games at Fetzer since the inception of the program in 1996.

♦ Carolina is 139-27 all-time at Fetzer Field, including 18-1 in NCAA Tournament games.

### RECENTLY IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

♦ The Tar Heels are 21-6 in the NCAA Tournament since 2009 and 13-2 since 2013, winning two national championships.

♦ In its last eight NCAA Tournament appearances, Carolina has:

- Advanced to the NCAA semifinals six times (2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016)
- Reached the NCAA championship game four times (2009, 2013, 2015, 2016)
- Won two NCAA championships (2013, 2016)

### CAROLINA'S NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

♦ UNC is 30-16 all-time in NCAA Tournament games and is making its 19th NCAA appearance.

♦ The Tar Heels have made nine semifinal appearances (1997, 1998, 2002, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016), including six in the last eight years. UNC has reached the NCAA title game four times, winning twice (2013, 2016).

♦ Carolina is 21-2 at home in NCAA Tournament games, losing only in 2000 to Loyola and in 2014 to Virginia. UNC has won 20 of its last 21 home NCAA Tournament games.

♦ The Tar Heels are 9-8 in NCAA Tournament quarterfinal games and have won six of their last eight quarterfinals, beating Notre Dame in 2009, Virginia in 2010, Loyola in 2011, Virginia in 2013, Penn State in 2015 and Notre Dame in 2016 while losing at Syracuse in 2012 and at home to Virginia in 2014 during that stretch.

♦ Carolina is 8-2 in quarterfinal games played in Chapel Hill. The Tar Heels are 1-6 in NCAA quarterfinal appearances played on the road.

♦ Carolina is 4-5 in NCAA semifinal games and has won three in a row.

♦ UNC is 15-1 with 15 consecutive wins in the NCAA Tournament second round.

◆ The Tar Heels are 2-2 in NCAA championship games, beating Maryland in 2013 and 2016 while losing to Northwestern in 2009 and Maryland in 2015.

◆ Head coach Jenny Levy has led Carolina to 19 NCAA Tournament berths, including 13 in a row. Levy's 29 NCAA Tournament wins rank fourth in the history of the sport.

◆ Carolina is making its 19th NCAA appearance in 22 years as a varsity program (since 1996).

◆ UNC is a top-five seed in the NCAA Tournament for the ninth year in a row.

## SERIES HISTORY VS. NAVY

◆ North Carolina leads the all-time series with Navy, 2-0.

◆ Both Tar Heel wins in the series came in the NCAA Tournament in Chapel Hill. Carolina began its 2010 and 2012 NCAA Tournaments with home wins over the Midshipmen.

◆ Former Tar Heel Aly Messinger (2013-16) is in her first season as an assistant coach and offensive coordinator at Navy after leading Carolina to NCAA titles in 2013 and 2016, including winning Most Outstanding Player honors last year. Messinger finished third all-time in pro-

◆ Kara Cannizzaro set the record with 83 points in 2013, and Abbey Friend is second in school history with 81 points in 2014.

#### RECORD-BREAKING OFFENSE IN 2017

◆ Carolina has scored a school-record 304 goals this season, breaking the single-season UNC record of 299 set in 2016.

◆ Carolina has a UNC-record 444 points this season, breaking the previous record of 442 set in 2016. Carolina has 414 points entering the NCAA Tournament.

## TAR HEEL TIDBITS FROM THE ACC & NCAA STATS

◆ UNC is second in the nation as a team in draw controls (17.47 per game), eighth in points per game (23.37), eighth in scoring margin (6.21) fourth in scoring offense (16.00) and first in shots per game (38.11).

◆ Molly Hendrick is sixth nationally with 69 goals. She also leads the ACC and is seventh nationally with 3.63 goals per game. Hendrick leads the ACC in shots per game (No. 2 in the nation) and shots on goal per game (No. 1 in the nation).

◆ Ela Hazard leads the ACC in assists (37) and assists per game (1.95).

## MCCOOL A FINALIST FOR TEWAARATON AWARD

◆ Junior midfielder Marie McCool is one of five finalists for the Tewaaron Award, the highest individual honor in the sport of lacrosse.

## CAROLINA HAS WON 23 OF LAST 24 VS. ACC

◆ Carolina has won 23 of its last 24 games against Atlantic Coast Conference opponents, losing only to Syracuse on April 15 this season in Chapel Hill since the 2015 ACC Tournament final.

## TAR HEELS ARE 34-2 IN LAST 36 GAMES

◆ The Tar Heels enter Saturday's game having won 34 of their last 36 games, dating back to early in the 2016 season.

◆ Prior to the Feb. 25, 2017, loss at Maryland, UNC won 20 games in a row, the longest winning streak in program history.

◆ Carolina closed its 2016 NCAA championship run on a 17-game winning

streak.

#### QUICK ON THE DRAW

◆ Carolina leads the ACC and is second in the nation with 17.47 draw controls per game as a team.

◆ Fifth-year senior Sammy Jo Tracy is among the nation's top draw control specialists. She is first in the ACC and fourth in the nation with 7.42 draw controls per game.

◆ Tracy enters Saturday's game vs. Navy with a school-record 141 draw controls this season. She broke her own school single-season record of 108, set last year, against Duke on April 22.

◆ Tracy also owns school records for most draw controls in a game (14 vs. High Point in 2016) and career (323).

◆ Carolina has won 332 draws this year as a team, a school record. The previous record was 295, set in 2016.

#### 300 WINS FOR LEVY

◆ On March 5, Levy won her 300th career game, becoming the third coach in NCAA Division I history to do so with a 16-8 win over Canisius. Levy joined Navy's Cindy Timchal and Princeton's Chris Sailer in the 300-win club.

◆ Levy has a record of 312-108 in her 22nd season as a head coach (all at Carolina).

#### FOUR TAR HEELS ON 2017 WORLD CUP TEAM

◆ US Lacrosse and U.S. women's senior team head coach Ricky Fried in January announced the 18-player U.S. Women's National Team that will compete in the 2017 Federation of International Lacrosse (FIL) Women's World Cup, July 12-22 in Guildford, England.

◆ Four Carolina players made the squad: midfielder Marie McCool (class of 2018), midfielder Laura Zimmerman (2012), defender Kristen Carr (2010) and defender Jennifer Russell (2010). McCool is one of two current college players to make the cut, the other being junior Gussie Johns, a goalie at USC.

#### 2016 SEASON REVIEW

◆ Carolina posted its best season in 2016, winning the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season title with a perfect, 7-0 record, winning the ACC Tournament and capturing its second NCAA championship along the way.

Levy has guided Carolina to 19 NCAA Tournament bids, nine NCAA Tournament semifinal appearances, three Atlantic Coast Conference titles and the 2013 and 2016 NCAA titles in her 21 seasons. She has been a mainstay on various NCAA, IWLCA and US Lacrosse national committees. She also is a four-time ACC Coach of the Year.

An outstanding women's lacrosse player at the University of Virginia from 1988-92 and an assistant field hockey and assistant women's lacrosse coach at Georgetown University from 1993-94, Levy was named as Carolina's first women's lacrosse coach in October 1994.

She is a 1992 graduate of the University of Virginia with a BA in rhetoric and communications and was a member of the U.S. National Team in 1992-93 and again in 1995. Levy (then known as Jenny Slingluff) played at UVA from 1988-1992. She led the Cavaliers to the 1991 NCAA championship, scoring three goals in the title game and five in the semifinal, leading to her selection as the tournament's Most Outstanding Attacker.

A two-time first-team All-America, Levy was named the 1992 NCAA Attacker of the Year. In 2002, she was named one of the top 50 players in ACC history.

She married Dan Levy of Baltimore, Md., in June 1998. Dan is a 1993 UNC graduate who played lacrosse at Carolina for four years, starting on the 1991 NCAA championship team. The couple has three children - Ryan (born in Jan. 2002), Alec (born in Sept. 2003) and Kathryn (born in July 2006).

In her 22nd season as the only head coach in UNC women's lacrosse history, Jenny Levy is among the top coaches in women's lacrosse annals. The owner of two national championships, she is third in NCAA Division I history in career wins, a two-time national champion and a two-time National Coach of the Year.

Levy has a career record of 312-108, including 66-30 in ACC play.

She has led the Tar Heels to nine appearances in the NCAA Tournament semifinals, including six in the last eight years. Her 29 NCAA Tournament wins are fourth in NCAA history.

Levy is the fourth coach in women's lacrosse history to win an NCAA championship as a player (with Virginia in 1991) and as a head coach. She is the eighth coach to win multiple NCAA titles.

In 2016, UNC set a school record for most wins (20) and fewest losses (two) in a season, went 7-0 in the ACC regular season and won the second ACC Tournament and NCAA Tournament titles in program history. The Tar Heels also won a program-record 17 games in a row to close the season. Levy earned National Coach of the Year honors after the season.

In 2013, Carolina beat defending national champion Northwestern in an NCAA semifinal, then bested top-ranked Maryland 13-12 in three overtimes for the title in one of the most thrilling games in the sport's history. She earned national-coach-of-the-year honors from Inside Lacrosse, the IWLCA and Lacrosse Magazine.

Former UNC players Kristen Carr, Amber Falcone and Jen Russell won gold medals with the U.S. National Team at the 2013 World Cup. Carr, Russell, Laura Zimmerman and Marie McCool are on the 2017 World Cup team.

"Jenny is the reason our team is so close, talking to us whenever we need, bringing her kids to practice, and pushing us as a team; she treats us more like family than players," says 2013 Honda Award winner Kara Cannizzaro.

The only head coach in UNC women's lacrosse history and among the collegiate game's most noted figures, Levy built the Tar

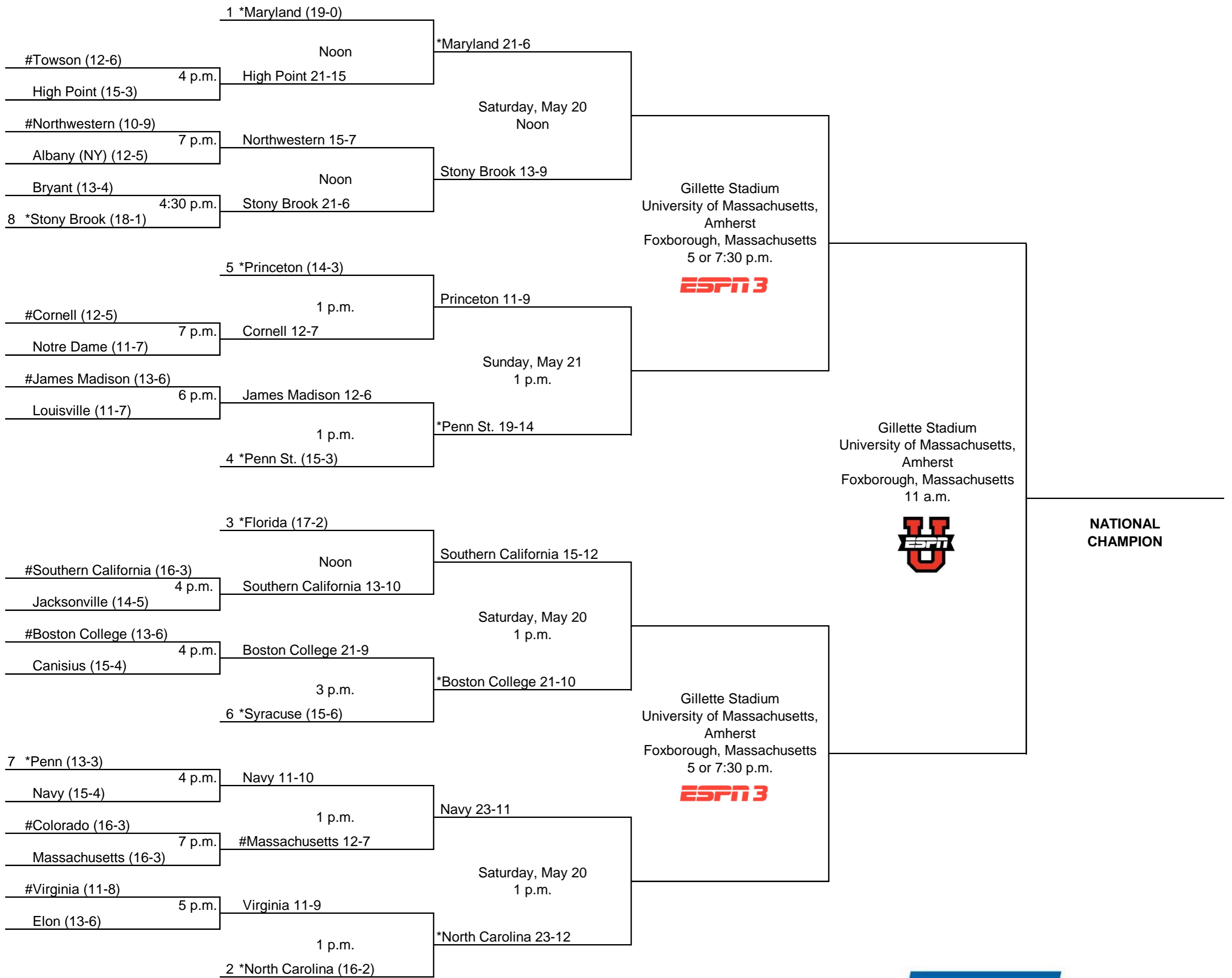
