SETTING THE STAGE

OPENING DRAW...

- Navy is 17-4 overall on the year, and 10-2 away from Annapolis (8-2 away, 2-0 neutral).
- Navy earned the Patriot League's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament winning its fifth PL Championship.
- The Navy women's lacrosse team defeated No. 7 Penn, 11-10, at Penn Park on Dunning-Cohen Champions Field in Philadelphia, Pa. With the win, the Midshipmen advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament to face UMass.
- The victory over No. 7 Penn (W, 11-10) in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament was the first win against a ranked opponent in Navy history. In addition, it was the second NCAA Tournament win for Navy in program history.
- Navy posted a 23-11 victory over UMass in the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the Mids to advance to the NCAA Tournament Quarterfinals for the first time in program history.
- The Mids have won 12 of the last 13 games overall. Seventeen wins in a season is tied for third most in a year with the 2010 season and behind the 2013 (19) and 2012 (18) seasons.
- Head coach Cindy Timchal is the all-time winningest head coach in NCAA history with 490 wins. She is coaching in her 26th NCAA Tournament – and fifth with Navy. Navy is 3-4 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.
- The Midshipmen are the third team that Timchal has led to the NCAA Tournament Quarterfinals. She advanced to the quarterfinals one year with Northwestern and 14 times with Maryland.

- Against UMass in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, six players combined for the Mids' 23 points on the day with five players recording hat tricks.
- **Julia Collins** tied the school record with eight goals in the game. She tied **Loren Generi** (at Longwood, April 2, 2013 and vs. UC Davis, March 27, 2013) and **Danielle Vivonetto** (vs. Manhattan, March 18, 2010) for most goals in a game in school history.
- **Kelly Larkin** paced the team with nine points, tallying three goals and a season-high six assists. **Jenna Collins** also recorded eight points on the day, finishing with two goals and a season-best six assists. **Kayla Harris** scored four goals – all in the second half. **Meg O'Donnell** and **Morgan Young** each added three goals apiece. Young finished the game with a season-best four assists.
- Defensively, **Ingrid Boyum** picked up her 17th win of the year, tying **Annie Foky** for most in a season. Foky finished the 2013 season 17-3. Boyum recorded seven saves in the game and grabbed two ground balls.
- The Midshipmen defense disrupted the Minutewomen's offense all day. Navy was credited with 13 caused turnovers out of UMass' 15 turnovers on the day. **Marie Valenti** led the way with four caused turnovers, and **Blake Smith** finished with three. **Sarah Childress** and **Boyum** each chipped in two caused turnovers apiece. With her three caused turnovers, Smith has 36 on the season, passing **Caitlin Mandrin-Hill** (34 in 2009) for most caused turnovers in a single season.
- Navy finished the game 20 ground balls and 20 draw controls. Valenti led the team with five ground balls, while Ju. Collins paced the team with eight draw controls.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENT...

- North Carolina enters the game with a 17-2 overall record. The Tar Heels won the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season with a 6-1 record and swept the ACC Tournament.
- UNC is making its 19th overall appearance in 22 years as a varsity program (since 1996) and 13th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance. North Carolina is 30-16 all-time in NCAA Tournament games.
- Carolina is the defending National Champions, defeating Maryland, 13-7, in the 2016 championship game. Navy assistant coach **Aly Messinger** was named the Most Outstanding Player of the Championship.
- The Tar Heels have made nine semifinal appearances (1997, 1998, 2002, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2015, 2016), including six in the last eight years. UNC has reached the NCAA title game four times, winning twice (2013, 2016).
- Carolina is 21-2 at home in NCAA Tournament games, losing only in 2000 to Loyola and in 2014 to Virginia. UNC has won 20 of its last 21 home NCAA Tournament games.
- UNC is 15-1 with 15 consecutive wins in the NCAA Tournament second round.
- The Tar Heels are 9-8 in NCAA Tournament quarterfinal games and have won six of their last eight quarterfinals. Carolina is 8-2 in quarterfinal games played in Chapel Hill.
- North Carolina is a top-five seed in the NCAA Tournament for the ninth year in a row.

CAROLINA CONNECTIONS...

- Navy assistant coach **Aly Messinger** was a four-year letterwinner for North Carolina (2013-16).
- She helped UNC win the 2013 and 2016 National Championships, being selected to the All-NCAA Tournament both years. She was named the Most Outstanding Player of the 2016 Championship.
- Volunteer assistant coach **Matt Holman** was a member of the North Carolina men's lacrosse team.
- Holman's dad Brian was an assistant coach for the men's team and his mother Laurie was the director of operations for the UNC women's lacrosse program.
- Holman's brother Marcus played lacrosse at Carolina, leaving UNC as a Tewaaraton Award finalist and the school's career scoring leader after the 2013 season, while his sister Sydney is currently a senior on the North Carolina women's lacrosse team.
- North Carolina assistant coach **Josh Dionne** was an assistant coach for Navy for two seasons (2015-16).

ALL-TIME SERIES...

- North Carolina leads the all-time series between the two schools, 2-0. The two teams met in the 2010 and 2012 NCAA Tournament.
- In 2010, Navy defeated Sacred Heart, 12-2, in the NCAA Play-In Game to advance to the first round of the NCAA Tournament to play North Carolina. The Tar Heels pulled out an 18-5 victory in the first ever meeting between the two schools.
- The Mids traveled to Eugene, Ore. and defeated Oregon, 10-9 in overtime, in the 2012 NCAA Play-In Game to once again meet the Tar Heels in the first round of the NCAA Tournament with UNC claiming a 14-7 win.
- Head coach Cindy Timchal is 11-9 all-time against the Tar Heels.

NCAA TOURNAMENT...

- The Mids are making their fifth appearance in the NCAA Tournament and the first appearance for Navy since 2013. The Midshipmen advanced to the NCAA Tournament after posting a 15-5 victory over top-seeded Loyola in the Patriot League Tournament, marking the team's fifth championship and ending the Greyhounds' 41-game winning streak against league opponents.
- Navy's first appearance in the NCAA Tournament was in 2010 as the Mids hosted Sacred Heart at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in the play-in game. The Midshipmen won the game 12-2 to advance to play No. 3 North Carolina in Chapel Hill, N.C. in the first round.
- The Mids returned to the NCAA tournament in 2011 as Navy once again hosted a play-in game, defeating Quinnipiac, 20-5, to advance to play top-seeded Maryland in College Park, Md.
- In 2012, Navy needed overtime to defeat Oregon, 10-9, in Eugene, Ore. in the play-in game. The Mids once again advanced to face North Carolina in Chapel Hill.
- The Mids most recent NCAA Tournament appearance saw Navy defeating Monmouth, 12-6, in Annapolis, before falling to No. 8 Duke, 10-5 in the second round.
- Navy advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second time with an 11-10 victory over No. 7 Penn on Friday. It was the first victory for the Mids over a ranked opponent in program history.
- The Mids moved on to the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history with a 23-11 victory over UMass in the second round of the Tournament.

TIP OF THE HAT...

- In 21 games this year, Navy has tallied 57 individual hat tricks.
- Jenna Collins** leads the team with 14, while **Morgan Young** is just behind with 11. For their careers, Je. Collins has 24 hat tricks and Young has 21.
- In addition, **Kelly Larkin** (8), **Meg O'Donnell** (8), **Julia Collins** (7), **Andie O'Sullivan** (5), and **Kayla Harris** (2) all have collected at least two hat tricks this year.
- The Mids have tallied three or more players with a hat trick in a single game in 10 of Navy's 21 games.
- Julia Collins** tied the school record with eight goals in the game against UMass. She tied **Loren Generi** (at Longwood, April 2, 2013 and vs. UC Davis, March 27, 2013) and **Danielle Vivonetto** (vs. Manhattan, March 18, 2010) for most goals in a game in school history.

CENTURY GOAL CLUB...

- In its 10 seasons, Navy has seen just 10 players tally 100 goals in their career.
- On Saturday, April 1, **Jenna Collins** joined the 100-goal club with four goals in a 22-7 victory over Army.
- Morgan Young** joined the 100-goal club with a five-goal performance at Colgate (W, 20-10) on April 8.
- Julia Collins** netted eight goals in a 23-11 victory over UMass in the second round of the NCAA Tournament to give her 100 for her career.
- Je. Collins ranks sixth in program history with 137 goals, while Young and Ju. Collins are eighth and 10th, respectively, at 119 and 100 goals.
- Erin Rawlick** (2008-10) owns the quickest mark to reaching 100 goals, as it took her just 29 games to reach the feat. Rawlick is third in career goals with 199.
- Only two players in program history have eclipsed 200 goals in a career. **Loren Green** (2012-15) holds the school record with 217, while **Aimee Gennaro** (2011-14) is second with 208 goals.

ALUMNI NEWS...

- On Saturday, April 1, the Naval Academy hosted the Washington Nationals and Boston Red Sox at Max Bishop Stadium in the final Spring Training exhibition game of the season. Former Navy women's lacrosse players **Abby Ellis** (2009-12) and **Baileigh Kimball** (2010-11) were part of the fly-by for the game.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME...

- Navy is no stranger to success at home, as it owns a 92-14 (.868) overall record at home. The Mids were 7-2 (.778) at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium this season.
- The Midshipmen have overwhelmed opponents at home this season, outscoring visiting team 133-74 (nine games).
- Leading the charge for Navy at home was **Kelly Larkin**. The freshman has amassed 47 points on 25 goals and 22 assists in nine games in Annapolis.

100-POINT PLATEAU...

- Fourteen (14) players in school history have notched 100 points in their career, including three players on the current roster - **Jenna Collins** (209), **Morgan Young** (158), and **Julia Collins** (144).
- Ju. Collins became most recent player to reach the feat as she tallied a three-point performance (1g, 2a) against Boston College (3/4/17) to accrue 100 points on 70 goals and 30 assists.
- One game earlier, Young eclipsed 100 points at George Washington (3/1/17). Young tallied five points on four goals and one assist to raise her career total to 103 points (85g, 18a). The Baltimore native accomplished the feat in 61 games played.
- Je. Collins reached the club in last season's Patriot League semifinal against Boston (5/6/16), tallying four goals in a 10-7 victory. It took Je. Collins 38 games to reach the milestone.
- Erin Rawlick** (2008-10) owns the program record for reaching 100 points the fastest, needing just 18 games.
- Both **Erin Rawlick** (2008-10) and **Jasmine DePompeo** (2010-13) are the only two players in program history to record 100 points in a single season. Both players tallied 100 points in a single season during their senior campaigns - Rawlick in 2010 and DePompeo in 2013.
- Kelly Larkin** (96) and **Meg O'Donnell** (76) are the next closest active players to the 100-point plateau.

SINGLE-SEASON MARKS...

- Several players are making their impact felt during the 2017 season and climbing up the single-season record book.
- Jenna Collins**, **Kelly Larkin**, **Morgan Young**, and **Julia Collins** are in top 25 for points scored in a season. Je. Collins is in third with 106 points, while Larkin ranks fifth with 96. Young is in 14th with 74 points and Ju. Collins is 15th with 70.

- Jenna Collins** (106) is just the third player in school history to record 100 or more points in a season. Freshman **Kelly Larkin** (96) is just four points shy of joining that exclusive group.
- Jenna Collins** (68) is second in goals scored in a year. She is nine back of tying for first. **Morgan Young** (50) is 16th on the list, seven back of the top 10.
- Kelly Larkin** leads the team with 52 assists, which is second in the single-season annals. In addition, **Jenna Collins** (38) and **Julia Collins** (26) are currently fifth and 13th on the list, respectively.
- With 45 ground balls this season, **Marie Valenti** is fourth on the single season list. She is one shy of third and two back of second. **Ingrid Boyum** is fifth with 44 ground balls.
- Julia Collins** (107) is fifth on the single-season draw control list. With eight draws against UMass, she joined **Loren Generi** (2012-15) and **Erin Rawlick** (2008-10) as the only players in school history with 100 or more draw controls in a season. **Jenna Collins** currently has 71 draw controls for a season ranking of ninth.
- Blake Smith** set the school record for most caused turnovers in a season with 36, breaking the previous record of 34 set by **Caitlin Mandrin Hill** (2008-11) in 2009. Earlier this season, the third-year player broke the junior record set by **Molly Doyle** (2014-16) in 2015. **Marie Valenti** is in third place with 33, while **Meghan Hubley** is sixth with 23. Hubley is one back of the top 5.
- Morgan Young** (16) is two free-position goals shy of tying **Kathy Young** (2010-13) for the most free-position goals in a season in Navy history. The senior is currently third, just ahead of teammate **Jenna Collins** (13) who is tied for fifth.
- At goal, **Ingrid Boyum** has 117 saves on the year to rank fourth in a season. Last season, Boyum made 129 saves, which is second in school history in a single season behind 144 stops by **Elaina Ponchione** (2009-12). Boyum has two of the Mids' six 100-save performances in a season.
- Ingrid Boyum** has 17 wins on the year, tying **Annie Foky** for most wins in a season, set in 2013. It is the ninth time in school history a goalkeeper has recorded double-digit wins in a season. Last year, she notched 13 Ws to tie for 4th in a year in school history.

CLIMBING THE RECORD BOOK...

- Navy has several players that are etching their name into the annals of the Midshipmen women's lacrosse record books.
- Jenna Collins** leads the team in career points with 209, ranking sixth in program history. In the NCAA Tournament against #7 Penn, she tallied five points (3 g, 2 a) to become the sixth player in school history with 200 or more career points.
- Morgan Young** (158), **Julia Collins** (144), **Kelly Larkin** (96), **Meg O'Donnell** (76), and **Andie O'Sullivan** (57) are all in the top 20 for career points. Young is ninth, while Ju. Collins is 11th. Larkin is 15th, O'Donnell is 16th, and O'Sullivan is 19th.
- Jenna Collins** (137) became the eighth player in school history with 100 goals, just ahead of **Morgan Young** (119) who became the ninth player one week later. **Julia Collins** (100) became the 10th player in school history with 100 or more goals following an eight-goal performance in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, helping the Mids to a 23-11 victory over UMass. **Meg O'Donnell** (66) is 15th, while **Kelly Larkin** (44) and **Andi O'Sullivan** (43) are in the top 20, ranking 17th and 18th.
- Jenna Collins** sits in fifth place in career assists with 72, while **Kelly Larkin** is in seventh place with 52. **Julia Collins** is ninth all-time with 44. **Morgan Young** is 11th on the list with 39 helpers.
- Only nine players in school history have scooped up 100 or more ground balls. **Jenna Collins** (97) is just three shy of becoming the 10th player in school history to accomplish the feat. **Meghan Hubley** (83), **Marie Valenti** (80), **Ingrid Boyum** (79), **Julia Collins** (62), and **Blake Smith** (58) are all in the Mids' top 25, ranking 15th, 16th, 17th, 22nd, and 24th, respectively.
- The Collins twins are third and fourth in the school record books for draw controls. **Julia Collins** has 192 career draw controls, while sister **Jenna Collins** has 188. **Marie Valenti** (40) is just 10 shy of becoming only the 16th player with 50 or more draws.
- Four players rank in Navy's career top 10 for caused turnovers. **Jenna Collins** (54) is fifth all-time, while **Blake Smith** (53), **Meghan Hubley** (49), and **Marie Valenti** (48) are sixth, seventh, and eighth, respectively.
- Navy has three players in the career top 10 for free-position goals. **Morgan Young** is in fourth place with 31, while **Jenna Collins** is in fifth with 29 free-position goals. **Julia Collins** (18) currently ranks ninth, but is just three shy of tying **Danielle Vionetto** (2009-12) for eighth.
- Ingrid Boyum** ranks third in program history with 252 career saves. Boyum also ranks third all-time in career wins with 30.
- Morgan Young** (77) is eighth in all-time games played. She is just ahead of teammate **Meghan Hubley** (75) who ranks 10th on the list. **Jenna Collins** (60), **Julia Collins** (60), and **Hubley** (60) are each tied for 12th in career games started.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN...

- Senior attack **Morgan Young** (Baltimore, Md.) and defender **Meghan Hubley** (West Chester, Pa.) will captain the 2017 Navy women's lacrosse team.
- Young, a 2016 Patriot League All-Tournament team honoree, shined in her first season as a starter. The senior attack started in 17 of Navy's 19 games last season and recorded career highs in points (42), goals (34) and assists (8).
- Young scored in bunches last season, as she tallied six hat tricks, which included three games of four goals. Overall, the Baltimore native scored in 14 of 19 games last year.
- Before last season, Young was one of the primary attackers that came off the bench as she saw action in 37 combined games her freshman (17) and sophomore (20) campaigns. She tallied a total of 42 points on 35 goals and 7 assists during her first two seasons.
- After seeing action in 15 games her freshman season, Hubley became a full-time starter on defense during her sophomore season. Since becoming a starter to begin the 2015 campaign, Hubley has started in every game.
- As a mainstay on the defense end the last two season, Hubley has consistently produced, recording at least 18 ground balls and 12 caused turnovers. The defender had a career high in ground balls with 21 last year.

OUR NATION'S FUTURE LEADERS...

- On May 27, Navy's seniors will graduate and be commissioned either 2nd Lieutenants in the Marine Corps or Ensigns in the Navy. Graduates serve a minimum of five years in the Navy or Marine Corps, while pilots serve eight years upon earning their wings.
- On Nov. 19, Navy's seniors received their service assignments. One will be commissioned 2nd Lieutenants in the Marine Corps, while four will serve as Ensigns in the Navy.

CINDY TIMCHAL • HEAD COACH • 10TH SEASON (35TH OVERALL)



Legendary head coach Cindy Timchal enters her 10th season at the helm of the women's lacrosse program at the United States Naval Academy in 2017. Timchal, who is entering her 35th year as a head coach, is the NCAA's all-time leader in career wins (473) in Division I women's college lacrosse.

Additionally, her eight national titles are the eighth most by a coach in a women's sport in NCAA history, and the 26th most in all sports, men and women combined.

Timchal was named the Midshipmen's first women's lacrosse coach on August 5, 2006, and in short order, has laid the foundation for a Navy program that is moving quickly in its quest to become a NCAA Division I power. In her eight seasons at the helm of the Midshipmen program, Navy has accumulated a terrific 124-32 (.795) record, won four Patriot League Championships and has advanced to four NCAA Tournaments (2010-13).

Timchal's coaching career got its start at Northwestern in 1982. During her nine-year tenure with the Wildcats, she compiled a 76-40 record (.655) while leading the program to five NCAA appearances. While at Northwestern, Timchal made it as far as the quarterfinals, earning appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 1983, '84, '86, '87, and '88. In 1991, she made the move to College Park to revive and renew the strong tradition of Terrapin lacrosse.

From Kelly Amonte Hiller to Cathy Reese, Alex Kahoe to Alexis Venechanos, Jen Adams to Kelly Coppedge, the one constant amongst all of the great Maryland players has been Cindy Timchal. In just five years of her 16 seasons at College Park did Timchal lose more than three games in any one season, highlighted by spectacular undefeated runs in 1996 (19-0), 1999 (21-0) and 2001 (23-0). She took Terrapin teams to the NCAA finals in 11 seasons, including an unprecedented stretch of seven straight national championships – currently the third-longest championship streak in women's NCAA history. In addition, the run puts Timchal in the company of coaching legends like UCLA's John Wooden who won seven straight titles with the UCLA men's basketball program from 1967-73.

A total of 53 different student-athletes have earned All-America recognition a total of 95 times under Timchal including Kelly Amonte Hiller's four, (1993-96), and three each for Betsy Elder (1992-94), Sarah Forbes (1995-97), Laura Harmon (1993-95), Sascha Newmarch (1996-98), Jen Adams (1999-01) and Kelly Coppedge (2002-04). In 2005, Acacia Walker earned first team honors, Greta Sommers was named to the second team and Annie Collines was named third team All-America. Adams' third-consecutive selection as Player of the Year in 2000 marked the 10th time one of Timchal's players have earned National Player of the Year honors, including Amonte Hiller, who was named the 1996 NCAA Division I Most Valuable Player. When the ACC's 50th anniversary Women's Lacrosse Team was announced in 2002, Timchal was selected as the head coach of the squad and had coached 22 members of the team.

Nationally, 18 of Timchal's players have played on the U.S. Developmental team and five were members of the most recent championship U.S. World Cup team. Seven former Terrapins helped lead Australia to the 2005 World Cup title in Annapolis, including tournament MVP Sarah Forbes. All totaled, 13 Terps represented three countries at the World Cup.
